**INDEMNITY BOND TO BE EXECUTED BY THE
GUARDIAN OF A MINOR**

(Referred to in Note 2 of clause 3 of Rule 118, Part III, K. S.R)

This deed of indemnity executed on thisday of
.....two thousandby Sri.(H.E.
names and addresses of the claimants)
.....(hereinafter referred to as “the claimants”) and
Sri.....and Sri.....(H.E. names and address
of the Sureties)(herein after referred to as “the
Sureties”) in favour of the Governor of Kerala (hereinafter referred
to as “the Government”).

Whereas the claimants have represented to the Government that
they are entitled to receive the sum of Rs.....(Rupees.....)
being the amount of death-cum-retirement gratuity of the deceased
Shri..... and that the amount may be paid to them they being the
surviving members of the family of Shri.....on their
executing an indemnity bond with two solvent surities as herein
after appearing;

And whereas the Government have been pleased to sanction the
request of the claimants subject to the condition that they should
execute an indemnity bond as hereinafter appearing with two
solvent sureties to which the claimants and the sureties have
agreed.

Now these presents Witnesseth as follows:

- (1) In consideration of the payment of the sum of ₹.....
(Rupees.....) to the claimants, the claimants and sureties hereby agree that they will at all times indemnify and keep indemnified the Government from all claims; losses and demands, if any, made or which may be made and all actions and proceedings taken or which may be taken against the Government by any person whom so ever in respect of the payment of the said amount to the claimants.
- (2) The claimants and sureties hereby further agree that all sums found due to the Government under or by virtue of this bond shall be recoverable jointly and severally from them and their properties movable and immovable under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force as though such sums are arrears of land revenue or in such other manner as the Government may deem fit.
- (3) The liability of the sureties under this deed is co-extensive with that of the claimants and shall not be impaired or affected by any variation in the terms and conditions herein contained or the Government giving time or any other indulgence to the claimants.
- (4) The stamp duty chargeable on the deed shall be borne by the Government.
